



GUINEA-BISSAU, NATURAL GATEWAY TO PORTUGUESE AND FRENCH-SPEAKING COUNTRIES

- Guinea-Bissau is the only Portuguese-speaking country in the West African Economic and Monetary Union (WAEMU), and which shares in common, the Currency, the Culture, Economic Policies.
- With about 80 islands and islets of the Bijagós archipelago, the Country has some of the most beautiful beaches in West Africa.
- ❖ It has enormous agricultural and forestry potential, which requires significant investments, particularly in the production of cashew nuts, which constitutes 80% of its exports. Guinea Bissau is ranked 3rd producer of cashew nuts in Africa, and 6th worldwide. Rice is the country's main crop.
 - ☐ Guinea-Bissau could achieve growth of 5.1% in 2024, according to the AfDB;
 - ☐ To diversify its economy, the country relies on four growth drivers: agriculture and agroindustry, fisheries, tourism and mining;
 - □ Bissau could become a logistics hub and a multi-sector Special Economic Zone (SEZ) to host agro-industrial activities (processing of cashew nuts, mango, fishery products), but also industrial activities;
 - □ In addition to administrative and tax incentives, the SEZ will provide a bouquet of efficient infrastructure and services, including buildings, energy, water, transport, digital technology and promotion and training services. A Special Tourist Zone (ZTS) is also planned in the Bijagós Islands, to make it a reference destination for sport fishing and ecotourism.

CONTEXT AND JUSTIFICATION – 1/2



« UEMOA, A COMMUNITY AREA WITH STRONG INVESTMENT POTENTIAL»

"Africa has an important role to play in driving inclusive growth and sustainable development globally. There are many opportunities for smart investments in key sectors: agriculture, energy markets, minerals, health infrastructure and pharmaceuticals, light manufacturing, transport and logistics, digital economy, etc. The continent remains a gold mine for savvy investors globally," said Mr. Kevin Urama, Chief Economist of the African Development Bank, during the presentation of the Africa Macroeconomic Performance and Prospects report.

For economist Jeffrey Sachs, tasked by United Nations Secretary-General Antonio Guterres with championing the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs): "Africa can and will achieve growth of 7% or more per year consistently in the coming decades."

The development of micro, small and medium-sized enterprises and industries (SMEs/SMIs) represents a real challenge for economic growth on the African continent, according to the African Development Bank. In a global context marked by climate change, the security crisis due to terrorist violence, the crisis in Ukraine with its pressures on energy resources and raw materials disrupting the supply chain and the production chain, SMEs are expected to be real actors in the economic growth of UEMOA and social change, given their importance in the economic fabric and through job creation, and the role they play in the development and dissemination of innovations.

CONTEXT AND JUSTIFICATION – 2/2



INTEGRATION OF SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS (SDGS) IS OF MAJOR IMPORTANCE FOR SMEs.

The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) provide a comprehensive framework to address the social, economic and environmental challenges facing UEMOA Member States, while encouraging them to adopt innovative approaches to financing development and the structural and inclusive transformation of their economies.

The 10th Edition of the UEMOA Banking and SME Show will have as its central theme "Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and Structural Transformation of African Economies: Role and Impact of UEMOA SMEs".

This central theme aims to highlight the importance of the SDGs and micro-small-medium enterprises and industries in the structural transformation of African economies, and particularly within the West African Economic and Monetary Union (UEMOA). This transformation is essential to ensure sustainable and inclusive economic growth on the continent.

This will be an opportunity to encourage innovation, competitiveness, collaboration, the adoption of responsible best practices and the financing of SMEs, in order to catalyze a transformative dynamic that promotes inclusive, sustainable and equitable growth within UEMOA Member States.

- For participants coming from countries where Guinea Bissau does not have diplomatic representation, arrangements can be made for the issuance of a visa upon their arrival.
- You can obtain a letter of invitation to the EXHIBITION to help you in your process of obtaining a VISA.
- Please note that the Embassy or consulate remains the sole decision-maker in obtaining your visa and is your only contact for any additional questions.

V- INTERNATIONAL VACCINATION CERTIFICATE

Recommended and/or mandatory vaccines: yellow fever, typhoid fever, meningitis.
